2015 In Review

From all of us at Mozingo Lake Recreation Park, THANK YOU for making 2015 such an amazing year! Record attendance at events, multiple sell-out camping weekends, increased off season occupancy... our patrons have definitely kept us on our toes, and we could not be more grateful!

There were many changes that came to the park in 2015. Probably the biggest one was the introduction of our new website in May. The newer design allowed visitors to place reservations, book tee times, view content on their mobile devices, and navigate through content easier. The website will receive additional updates throughout the Off Season to better serve our patrons.

In terms of programming, the park introduced Mozingo Movie Nights, which displayed a film each Friday night at the Main RV Campground during the months of June and July. Crowd size averaged at 70-80 people on nights the weather cooperated. And as part of our 20th Anniversary, we hosted our first Mud Volleyball Tournament, beach party, MOERA Open House, Little Mr. & Misses Mozingo Pageant, and Family Fun Zone. Many of these activities and events campers/guests may look forward to seeing again in 2016, along with a few others that are currently in the works.

And in terms of improvements and additions to the park, we have reshaped and laid out new sand for the MLRP Beach; increased our dock capacity at our boat ramps; completed our paved walking trail, which begins near The Point and loops at the Main RV Campground; introduced free wi-fi to the cabins and campgrounds; and cleared out a majority of the underbrush in the Primitive Tent Camping Area, giving it more natural light and air flow. Still to come for 2016 will be the completion of Cabin #8; playground and basketball court improvements; and the long awaited opening of the Watson 9.

So much accomplished in one year, so much more to look forward to for the next! Again, thank you all for making this year a great success. Until next time, friends ...

Craft Materials:

- Twigs (pencil sized diameter)
- Hot Glue Gun
- Push Pin
- Pen and Pencil
- Christmas colored pipe cleaner
- Cardboard pieces

- Pine Cones
- Satin Ribbon
- Jute rope
- Hot Glue Gun

Step-by-step instructions for each craft can be viewed by clicking on each photo. As an added tip, we recommend drying out pinecones and twigs in an oven on low heat to assure they are free of pests.
