Mozingo Lake Golf Course Upcoming Tournaments

Here's an update on some of our larger tournaments coming to the Mozingo Lake Recreation Park Golf Course this summer.

On Sunday, June 14th, we will be hosting the Break 80 Challenge. This is a "late-bloomers tour" event meaning there will be senior amateur golfers from the Missouri and Kansas area playing in this event. Mozingo was chosen as one of the



qualifying courses for this relatively new tour. Players will sign up to play at one of the numerous qualifying courses around Missouri and Kansas and then the top-finishers from each site will move on to compete in the final event at the Lake of the Ozarks. Mozingo was found through GolfNow and chosen for its considerable difficulty in this region of the state.

And on June 22nd, we will be home to the Midwest PGA Pro/Pro event. This is a Midwest PGA section event meaning there will be PGA professional golfers from numerous courses around Missouri coming to compete with a partner. These two-man professional teams will compete against each other for a cash tournament purse paid out by the Midwest PGA. To qualify for the event, one must be a professional member of the Midwest PGA section. The Midwest PGA tournament committee selected Mozingo to host this event through a bid process.

Bird Hunters United Nationals

For the second year in a row, Bird Hunters United will be hosting their nationals event February 6th through February 8th at Mozingo Lake Recreation Park. The event will consist of flushing and pointing competitions. Nationals this year is expected to bring out 60 handlers and 70 dogs, all coming in from six states: Illinois, Missouri, Nebraska, Iowa, Arkansas and Kansas. There will be different divisions, including ones for women and youth. We look forward to the results of this event; and wish all handlers and dogs good luck!

Mountain Man Dutch Oven Breakfast

Prep Time: 15 minutes

Cook Time: 45 minutes

Serves: 12 people

Ingredients:

- 1 lb mild pork sausage, crumbled
- 6 strips of bacon, cooked and sliced
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1 red bell pepper, chopped
- 2 lb package from hash browns
- 12 eggs, beaten
- 1 package shredded cheddar cheese

Directions

Cook and stir sausage, onion and garlic in a 12-in cast iron Dutch oven with lid, raised over the coals to medium-high heat, until the sausage is no longer pink and the onion is tender.

Stir the red bell pepper, green pepper, and hash browns until evenly mixed. Cook stirring occasionally, until the hash browns are hot and the peppers are tender, about 15 minutes.

Pour beaten eggs evenly over the top of the potatoes, allowing them to sink into the potatoes. Cover the Dutch oven. Place 6 to 9 coals underneath, and 12 to 18 on top. Allow to bake until eggs are firm, about 40 minutes.

Sprinkle cheddar cheese, cover and continue cooking until the cheese has melted about 5 minutes.

Serve and enjoy!
